Each applicant must include a letter of nomination (must be part of the application, *not* a separate document) from their Department Chair or Program Director to confirm that the application is the candidate(s) endorsed by the institution for the award chosen.

- IX. Mentorship Letters of Support (for trainees) (**not to exceed one page for each Co-PI**)

For clinical or postdoctoral fellows, a letter of support from the mentor detailing the program should be included. This can be submitted in conjunction with the Chair letter (Part VIII).

FORMATTING AND PAGE LIMITATIONS

For all sections:

- § Use a minimum font size of 11 in Arial or Times New Roman font.
- § Use a minimum margin setting of 0.5 inches.
- § All sections should be double spaced, except the Reference and Biographical sketch sections which may be single spaced.

Biographical Sketch:

- § Limit listed publications to those relevant to the proposed research during the past three years and two representative earlier publications pertinent to this application.

Page Limit

- § The total page limit for all materials including all letters of nomination and support is 25 pages. Page limit restrictions on individual sections should be applied as above. No appendix materials are to be submitted.
